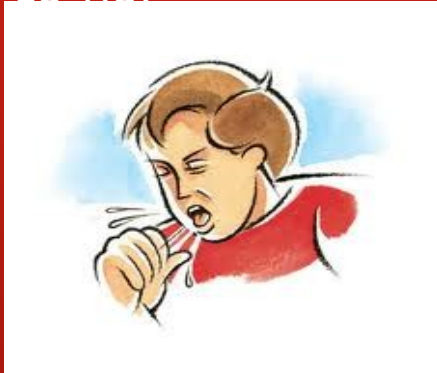

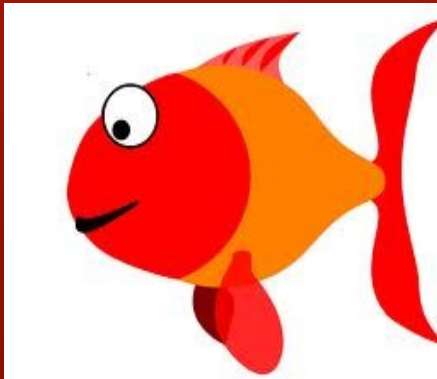


Effects
